- 3.3 Mendocino Coast Humane Society Signage Plan
 - Sarah Huff reported that she has met on site with Jennifer Garrison, a Biologist with the State of CA., Department of Fish and Wildlife, to discuss the proposed location for the Humane Society sign. From this meeting, it was determined that the sign and the proposed placement could receive an exemption from further environmental review processes, as long as the sign is placed on the rise, behind the drainage.
 - Chuck Tourtillott had questions about the height of the sign and if it was okay to trim the single Scotch Broom tree back for the purpose of enhancing the visibility of the sign. He also asked about completing and filing the required exemption.
 - Sarah Huff said she would complete and file the exemption for the humane Society with the fee to be paid by the Humane Society.
 - \circ $\,$ Dan Keyes had questions about the sign review and approval process.
 - Bob Bushansky explained that because the Humane Society already had an agreement with the District for sign placement and the Humane Society was replacing an existing sign, no further review or action by MCRPD was necessary. Bob also had questions about the color of the sign and requested a mock-up of the sign display.
 - Sarah Huff believes it would be a good idea to have Jennifer Garrison at the next Regional Park Committee meeting.

3.4 PG&E Fuel Break

- Concerns were raised regarding maintenance of the utility easement and the anticipated project timeline as it relates the bird nesting season.
