1.0. CALL TO ORDER

- Bob Bushansky: Talked about current agreement with CRA and discussed the idea to provide some type of pass for access.
- John Huff: Talked about the OHV grant and explained his position with both MCRPD and CRA.
 He went further to discuss clean-up opportunities and recommend for Ms. Blue to contact Sarah Huff in regards to providing patrolling services.
- Bob Bushansky: Spoke to developing a policy for use of property with a possible review of the proposed policy at the September 20, 2017 Ad Hoc Regional Park Advisory Committee.
- A general discussion was held regarding he abuse of the property by continued illegal use.

- 4.1 State of California, 2017 OHV Planning and Restoration Grant Programs
 - John Huff: Spoke to the notice of exemption for the EIR requirements. Asked the committee to consider a new project starting date.

 accounts had been established and only required a signature from Dan to complete the
